<p><b>Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March</b>            Read: Psalm 120  <b>Together: Lord's Prayer</b>            Philippians 1:1-11  <i>Focus on v1: All Christians are 'saints', which means 'made holy', set apart for God's use.</i>            Pray: Ask for any particular needs  <b>Together: Psalm 117 (it's only 2 verses)</b></p>	<p><b>Monday 30<sup>th</sup> March</b>            Read: Psalm 125  <b>Together: Lord's Prayer</b>            Philippians 1:1-11  <i>Focus on v9-11: Paul prays for 'more and more' love, knowledge and righteousness</i>            Pray: Ask for any particular needs  <b>Together: Psalm 118:28-29</b></p>
<p><b>Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> March</b>            Read: Psalm 121  <b>Together: Lord's Prayer</b>            Philippians 1:1-11  <i>Focus on v2: 'Grace' = God gives undeserved gifts; 'Peace' = the undeserved gift God gives. Peace with God means peace in everything.</i>            Pray: Ask for any particular needs  <b>Together: Psalm 117</b></p>	<p><b>Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> March</b>            Read: Psalm 126  <b>Together: Lord's Prayer</b>            Philippians 1:1-11  <i>Focus on v11: 'to the glory and praise of God'. This is to be the goal of our entire lives.</i>            Pray: Ask for any particular needs  <b>Together: Psalm 118:28-29</b></p>
<p><b>Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> March</b>            Read: Psalm 122  <b>Together: Lord's Prayer</b>            Philippians 1:1-11  <i>Focus on v3-5: Partnership in the Gospel. Paul rejoices that other Christians have received the same grace from God that he has.</i>            Pray: Ask for any particular needs  <b>Together: Psalm 117</b></p>	<p><b>Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> April</b>            Read: Psalm 127  <b>Together: Lord's Prayer</b>            Philippians 1:12-14  <i>Paul saw everything – even being put in prison – as an opportunity</i>            Pray: Ask for any particular needs  <b>Together: Psalm 118:28-29</b></p>
<p><b>Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> March</b>            Read: Psalm 123  <b>Together: Lord's Prayer</b>            Philippians 1:1-11  <i>Focus on v6: God always finishes what he starts: and that means that we can be totally confident he will bring us into Jesus' Kingdom when he returns to judge.</i>            Pray: Ask for any particular needs  <b>Together: Psalm 117</b></p>	<p><b>Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> April</b>            Read: Psalm 128  <b>Together: Lord's Prayer</b>            Philippians 1:15-18  <i>All that matters is that Christ is preached – Paul doesn't even care if people do so for the wrong reasons!</i>            Pray: Ask for any particular needs  <b>Together: Psalm 118:28-29</b></p>
<p><b>Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March</b>            Read: Psalm 124  <b>Together: Lord's Prayer</b>            Philippians 1:1-11  <i>Focus on v7-8: Paul loves his fellow-Christians because they share in his suffering and his standing for the gospel.</i>            Pray: Ask for any particular needs  <b>Together: Psalm 117</b></p>	<p><b>Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> April</b>            Read: Psalm 129  <b>Together: Lord's Prayer</b>            Philippians 1:19-20  <i>Paul will not be ashamed, because Christ will be honoured</i>            Pray: Ask for any particular needs  <b>Together: Psalm 118:28-29</b></p>
