## Prayer of thanksgiving

### Baptism of Aaron Gomes

#### Explanation of Baptism

##### Statement of Faith

I believe in God, the Father almighty,  
creator of heaven and earth.

I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord,  
who was conceived by the Holy Spirit,  
born of the Virgin Mary,  
suffered under Pontius Pilate,  
was crucified, died, and was buried;  
he descended to the dead.

On the third day he rose again;  
he ascended into heaven,  
he is seated at the right hand of the Father,  
and he will come again to judge the living and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit,  
the holy catholic Church,  
the communion of saints,  
the forgiveness of sins,  
the resurrection of the body,  
and the life everlasting.

1. Do you believe that the death which baptism symbolises should by rights  
have been yours, and Aaron's, were it not for Christ's death for you, taking the  
penalty for your sins?

2. Do you believe that the washing from sin, new life and outpouring of the  
Spirit which baptism symbolises come only through Christ's death and  
resurrection?

3. Do you therefore understand that people can only be saved through faith in  
Jesus Christ, and not through anything they can do?

4. Do you renounce the world, the flesh and the devil, and commit yourself to  
the service of Christ from this day forwards?

5. Do you yourself trust in Christ alone for your salvation, and understand that  
Aaron must do so too, if his baptism is to be of any value to him/her?

#### Membership Promises

##### Baptismal Promises

4. Do you therefore promise to bring Aaron up in the instruction, obedience  
and worship of the Lord, to pray for him, and to be an example of faith and  
life?

5. Do you promise to teach him what his baptism means, and assist him in  
every possible way to lead a life of devoted service to his Lord and Saviour?

##### Congregational Charge

Aaron is to be baptised into the visible Church of Jesus Christ, and will  
become a member of this congregation. Therefore we who are members  
are all obliged to love and receive him as a fellow-member of Christ's  
body, for 'we were all baptised into one body'. You must recognise your  
duty to encourage him in his Christian life by godly example, prayer,  
exhortation and practical concern.
